Immunization Records Now Due

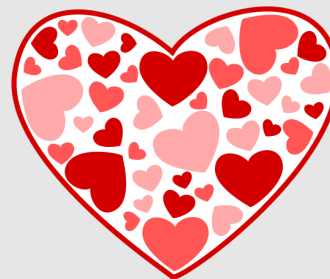
