CENTER UPDATE

Restoration work is moving forward at SCC.

I have two pieces of news to share with you: First, the unfortunate news that our insurance claim received final denial, thus giving us no monetary support for our restoration project. An independent engineer was called out to give his input and came to do a full inspection. While we thought he saw what we saw, a clogged downspout drain from the playground surface under our playground and into the parking lot, he concluded the clog came from the downspout beginning on top of the roof. This piece of information caused the insurance company to deny our claim. Second, the good news: the metal framing for our pony wall between the Infant and Toddler 1 classrooms has been installed. Drywall is being installed in the coming days. Then all we have left to do is paint and flooring. We are working with our own flooring contractor, as he can give us a better price on not only materials but labor,. We are hopeful we can finish this project and move back to SCC in the near future!
